EMERGENCY CLOSING DAYS: If more than four (4) days are used for emergency closings, school will be in session during Spring Recess (April 5-9) as follows. If we use 5 days, school will be in session on Friday of Spring Break, For 6 days, Thursday and Friday of Spring Break. For 7 days, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday of Spring Break. For 8 days, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday of Spring Break. For 9 days, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday Thursday and Friday of Spring Break. Should emergency closing days not be used, these days will be taken off of the end of the school year or used to extend the Memorial Day weekend. Please plan accordingly.

Last 4 days of school -- Reduced schedule for students: Four (4) hour teaching sessions shall be established for all pre-kindergarten through 6th grade classes on the last four (4) days of school and for all 7th and 8th grade classes on the last two (2) days of school.
