

## **SMOKING**

It is the posture of the Surgeon General of the United States that smoking is injurious to the health of the smoker. Professional organizations have also indicated their opposition to this habit. Coupled with this health hazard, carelessness with cigarettes and matches represents a peril involving the safety of everyone in the school plant.

Since we believe smoking is detrimental to the over-all interest of the school, and consistent with Board of Education policy, a strict regulation of No Smoking will be enforced.

The following conditions shall prevail:

1. There is to be absolutely no smoking on school grounds. Should a student be found smoking outside the building, his/her parents will be contacted immediately and he/she will be assigned five days detention.
2. If a student is found smoking on a second occasion outside the building, he/she will be suspended from school. (Saturday School is an option.)
3. Should a student be found smoking inside the building at any time, he/she will be suspended or assigned to Saturday School. (Note: State law calls for notification of authorities, which may result in a fine to be paid as assessed by the courts.)
